Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as determined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The prescriptions of US Sailing will apply and will be stated in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3. Equipment is required to conform to the rules of the International Laser Class Association.
- 1.4. An arbitration system will be utilized with three members of the fleet listening to both participating boats and no witnesses. If a boat acknowledges fault then the at fault boat will only be penalized 50% of a full DSQ.

2. Advertising

- 2.1. Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. Competitors who are members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association, may enter by completing registration with the organizing authority. If five or more Radials are registered, they will have their own start, scoring and trophies. Rig switches will not be permitted.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form at the time of registration.

4. Fees

- 4.1. The required fees are as follows. Laser \$30.00. Laser Radial \$30.00 Checks (made out to Madison Sailing Center or online at regattanetwork.com click on calendar and look for July 18th District 20
- 4.2. Entry fee includes: Launching, Racing and pre-race snacks before racing on both days and a quick Barbeque after racing on Saturday.

5. Schedule

- 5.1. Registration: Saturday, July 18, 2009 from 9:00 to 11:00 AM.
- 5.2. Competitors Briefing: Saturday, July 18th, 2009 at 11:00 AM
- 5.3. Dates of Racing: Saturday July 18th & 19th, 2009.
- 5.4. The scheduled time of Warning Signal for the First Race is 12:00AM on Saturday and 10:00 AM on Sunday
- 5.5. No Warning Signal will be made after 2:00 PM on Sunday.
- 5.6. An informal gathering at the Wisconsin Union on Friday is encouraged at the Hooper Sailing Club. With the possibility of participating in Friday Night Tech Dinghy Racing. Call ahead for details if interested.

6. Sailing Instructions

- 6.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

7. Venue

- 7.1. The Madison Sailing Center is located on the near Maple Bluff on the north side.

The racing area will be the North side of Lake Mendota, in and outside of Warner Bay. More details will be announced at the Competitors Briefing.

8. Courses

- 8.1. The Courses to be sailed will be modified Windward-Leeward or modified Triangle or combinations of both.

9. Scoring

- 9.1. The Low Point Scoring System described in appendix "A" of the RRS will apply, a boats worst race will be discarded if 7 or more races are completed.
- 9.2. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. No more than twenty races will be held.

10. Radio Communications

- 10.1. A boat will neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to cellular telephones.

11. Prizes

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded as follows: Laser Fleet – Top 3, Laser Radial Fleet – Top. Top Junior. No Masters Scoring or prizes will be awarded at this event. This is an open event.
- 11.2. The District 20 Championship Perpetual Plaque and Trophy is currently unavailable and will not be awarded. If you see it let us know.

12.Disclaimer of Liability

- 12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race
- 12.2. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
